Section I – Logical Reasoning (10 Marks)

This section aims to evaluate the candidate's analytical and reasoning skills. The syllabus includes:

1. Analytical Reasoning
2. Verbal Reasoning
3. Abstract Reasoning
4. Logical Sequencing
5. Problem-Solving and Logical Deduction

Section II – General Knowledge (10 Marks)

This section assesses awareness of constitutional, legal, and general developments. The syllabus includes:

1. Indian Constitution
2. Indian Political System
3. Important Legal Personalities and Jurists
4. Legal Doctrines and Latin Maxims
5. Basic Current Legal Awareness

Section III – Legal Aptitude (10 Marks)

This section evaluates foundational legal understanding and conceptual clarity. The syllabus includes:

1. Principles of Natural Justice
2. Law of Contracts
3. Basics of Constitutional Law
4. Basic Principles of Criminal Law
5. Law of Torts

Section IV – English Language Skills (10 Marks)

This section tests language proficiency and comprehension. The syllabus includes:

2. Grammar (Fill in the blanks, sentence correction, rearrangement)
3. Correct Spelling of Words

4. Plural Forms and Usage of Legal Terms
