

Anti- Ragging Policy

MKPM RV Institute of Legal Studies, Bengaluru is committed to providing a safe, inclusive, and respectful academic environment. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the campus and in all college-related activities.

This Policy is framed in accordance with the [UGC Regulations](#) on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, directions of the Supreme Court of India, and applicable laws in force.

The College adopts a zero-tolerance approach towards ragging.

Definition of ragging:

Ragging includes any conduct whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which:

- Has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Indulges in rowdy or undisciplined activities causing annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm.
- Causes fear, shame, embarrassment, or humiliation.
- Includes physical abuse, verbal abuse, sexual harassment, or economic exploitation.
- Compels a student to perform acts they would not ordinarily do.
- Occurs in person, online, or through social media.

Ragging is a punishable offence under law.

This Policy applies to all students on-campus and off-campus college-related activities, including study tours, internships, and online platforms.

Reporting mechanism:

Any student may report ragging through:

- Written complaint to the Principal.
- Direct approach to Anti-Ragging Cell members.
